

# Storm Damage Checklist

## FROM THE GROUND

- Look for missing or curled shingles
- Spot any visible sagging or dark patches
- Check for debris or branches on the roof
- Inspect gutter for shingle granules or dents

## INSIDE YOUR HOME

- Check ceilings and attic for water stains or leaks
- Look for signs of moisture around light fixtures or vents
- Sniff for a musty odor (hidden leaks)
- Listen for dripping during rain

## DOCUMENTATION

- Take clear photos of all visible damage
- Save for insurance or inspection
- Capture wide shots and close-ups for insurance
- Note the date and time the damage was observed

## NEXT STEPS

- Call a trusted, local roofing professional
- Avoid DIY repairs—your safety comes first
- Schedule a full roof evaluation
